This is a breakdown of the ladder weave. This weave can be done with different quantities of base wires. In this case 6 are being used hence the name 6-1 weave.

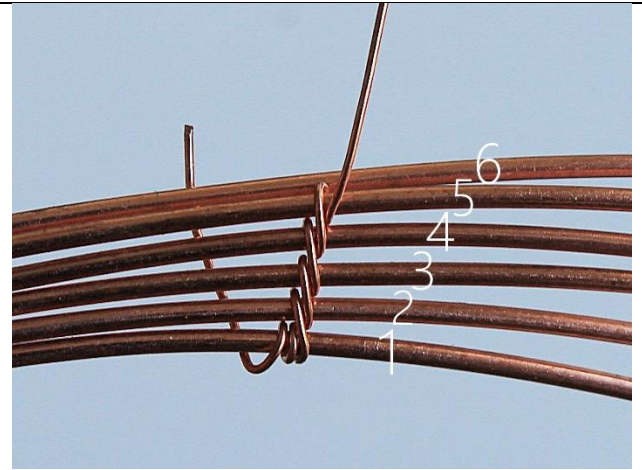
# 6/1 Weave AKA Ladder Weave

	<p><b>Step 1</b></p> <p>Start by securing the weaving wire by wrapping twice around the first (bottom) wire.</p> <p>This step is only done at the beginning of the weave and will not be repeated in the main pattern.</p>
	<p><b>Step 2</b></p> <p>Wrap the weaving wire up and between wires 2 &amp; 3 and then down and between wires 1 &amp; 2</p>
	<p><b>Step 3</b></p> <p>Wrap up and in between wires 3 &amp; 4 and then come forward between wires 2 &amp; 3</p>



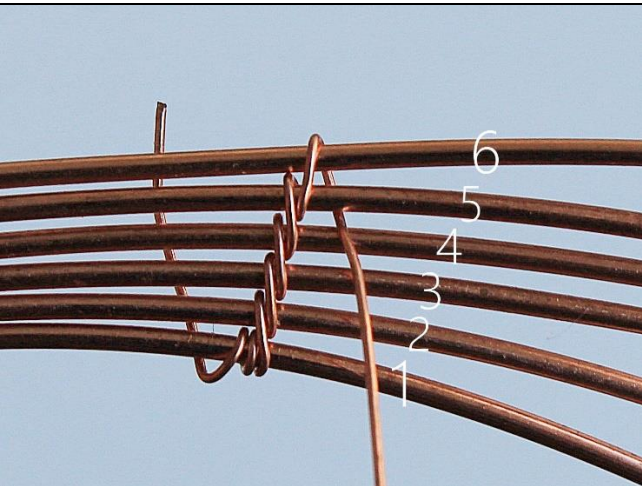
Step 4

Wrap up and between wires 4 & 5 and then forward between wires 3 & 4.



Step 5

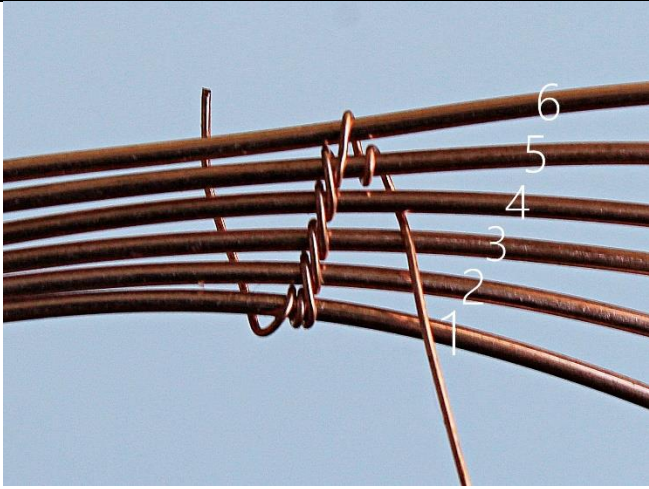
Wrap up and between wires 5 & 6 and then come forward between wires 4 & 5



Step 6

Wrap up and over wire 6 and **\*then down and forward between wires 5 & 4**

\*Note the change on base wires 1 & 6 you will be changing direction and not coil entirely around the base wire



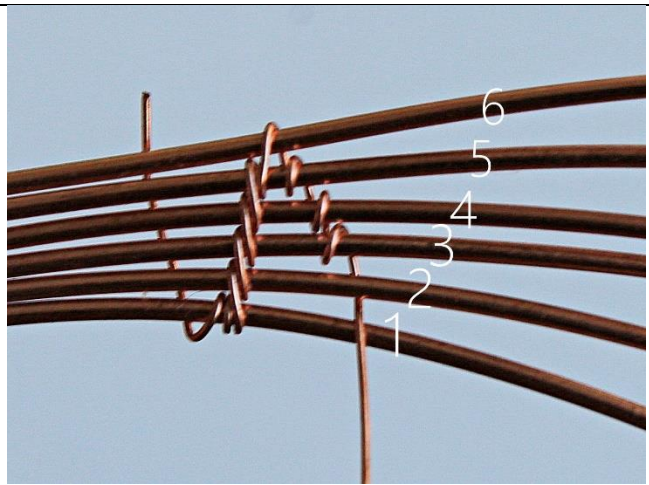
Step 7

Wrap up and between wires 5 & 6 then down and forward between wires 3 & 4



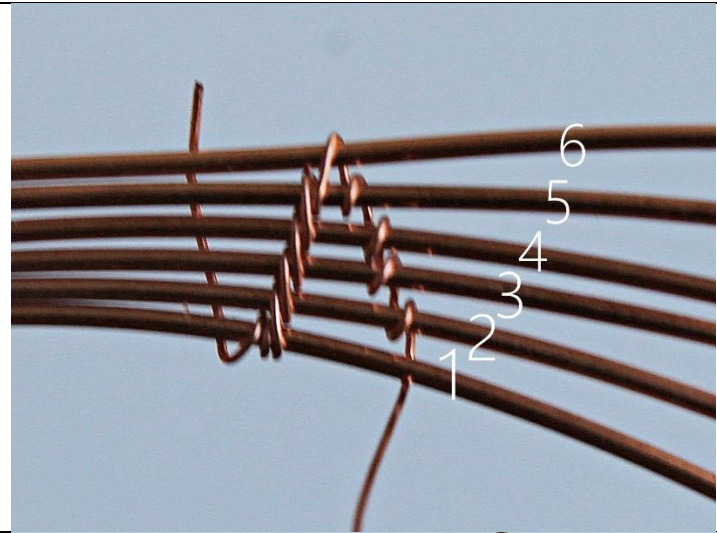
Step 8

Wrap up between wires 4 & 5 then down and forward between wires 2 & 3



Step 9

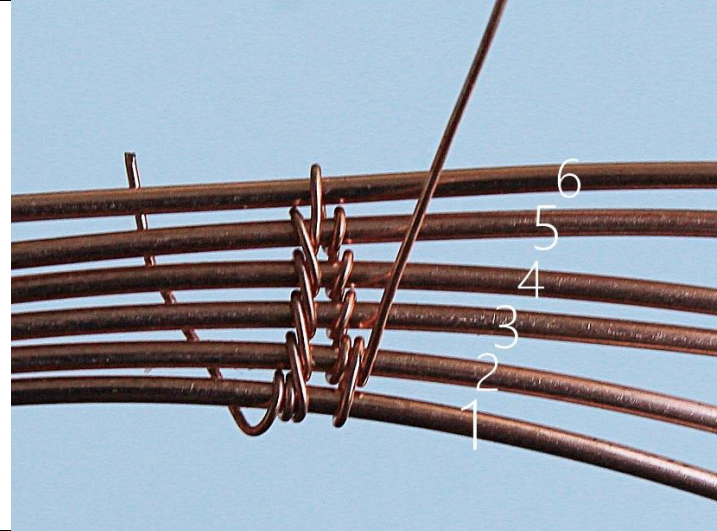
Wrap up and between wires 3 & 4 then down and forward between wires 2 & 1.



#### Step 10

Wrap up and between wires 2 & 3 and then down and come forward on the bottom side of wire 1

This is 1 rotation for this weaving pattern



#### Step 11

Continue with steps 2 – 10

Be sure to compress the weave together between rotations.
